Dear Parents and Students,

Our School-Based Health Center (SBHC) located on school grounds is a primary care health center that serves the students of N.O. Charter Science & Mathematics High School. Health services are provided by LSU Health Sciences Center Department of Pediatrics.

We are open year-round, Monday - Friday 8:00am- 4:30pm, and provide health services to adolescents ages 10 and up. The health center accepts all patients with or without health insurance.

The Health Center provides access to:

- Pediatricians
- Nurse Practitioners
- Registered Nurses
- Behavioral Health Specialist (a counselor)
- Ophthalmology

Services offered at the SBHC include:

- Physicals, including sports physicals
- Immunizations including COVID-19 vaccine
- Treatment of minor illness and injury
- Monitoring of chronic illnesses such as diabetes, asthma, and obesity
- Mental health and substance abuse help and counseling services
- STD testing
- Routine lab tests, including COVID-19 testing

Our staff works closely with LSUHSC Tiger Care Pediatric/Adolescent Clinics and Children's Hospital to provide specialty care not available at the SBHC.

We are supported in part by the Office of Public Health's Adolescent School Health Program, the LSU School of Medicine, and other grant money. We support education and growth in our community by reducing school absenteeism and parental leave from work.
