



## Sci High 2024-2025 Student & Parent/Guardian Orientation Dates & Guidelines

Each grade level has been scheduled at a designated orientation time and date. **These mandatory orientation days are important and ALL students should plan to attend with their parents/guardians.** Students and parents will meet Sci High administration, faculty and staff, learn important school expectations and details from various departments, receive their class schedule, take their yearbook and ID picture, complete and return important paperwork, pay school supplemental budget and more. **School bus transportation will run their normal routes for all orientation dates. Students should report in full Sci High approved uniform.**

**REMINDERS:**

As per Act 313 **School Cellphone Restrictions: Beginning with the upcoming 2024-25 school year, all public school students, including charter school students, are prohibited from possessing an electronic telecommunications device (i.e., a cell phone, smart watch, etc.) throughout the instructional day.** If a student brings such a device to school, the device must either be turned off and properly stowed for the duration of the instructional day or prohibited from being turned on and used during the instructional day.

The official attendance taking period is the 1st Period of the day beginning at 8:08 a.m. and students arriving after this time will be marked Tardy for the day. The academic schedule ends each day at 3:24 p.m., with buses departing at 3:34 p.m.

### STUDENT'S FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

**MONDAY, AUGUST 12TH, 7:45A.M.**

The student gate (N. Johnson Street) entrance will not open until 7:45 a.m. Please do not have students arrive before that time as they cannot be monitored. We ask that the N. Johnson Street bus loading zone is not blocked and that non school bus riders (car or van riders) be dropped off and picked up on Bienville Street and can walk to/from the N. Johnson Street gate entrance.

### UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

**Students are required to report to Orientation in full uniform.** Sci High dress code policies support a positive school culture by identifying attire that promotes school safety and student health. School staff will inform students, parents/guardians, and the school community of the uniform policy.
