

OGDEN MUSEUM OF SOUTHERN ART IS NOW TAKING TEEN INTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS!

Are you interested in visual arts?

Are you eager to learn about artists and new art-making techniques?

Do you want to engage in critical conversations about art, interpretation and social justice?

Are you curious as to what goes on in an art museum?

Ogden Museum of Southern Art's Teen Internship Program, formerly the Ogden Museum Teen Docent Program, is designed to provide teens a space to explore the arts and develop their creative voice. Over the summer, Teen Interns participate in five weeks of training, learning and assisting the Fine Arts Fundamentals camp, followed by a three-week intensive, featuring museum career exploration, community outreach, engagement with other cultural institutions and art workshops. During the school year, Teen Interns meet monthly to further develop their artistic practice through artist workshops, curation of a teen exhibition and assisting with Museum programming.

Applicants must be students in an Orleans or Jefferson Parish public school; currently in the 9th, 10th or 11th grade; interested in the arts, education and/or working with children. Teen Interns receive a stipend of \$1000 for the 8-week summer program and \$50 per meeting during the school year.
